THEME-DISCIPLINE AND SAFETY

Classes Involved: Grade 3,4& 5

As part of our school's ongoing efforts to inculcate important values and life skills among students, a co-curricular activity was organized on the theme "Safety and Discipline". The event aimed to raise awareness about personal safety, responsible behavior, and the importance of discipline in daily life both within and outside the school campus.

Activities Conducted

Poster-Making Competition: Children created colorful and meaningful posters highlighting safety signs, emergency numbers, and slogans about discipline. Selected posters were displayed on school bulletin boards.

Safety Awareness: A student-led awareness program on "Safety and Discipline" was conducted. The initiative was designed, organized and presented by students. They took the lead in educating their fellow schoolmates on crucial aspects of personal safety and the importance of disciplined behaviour.

Discussion Session: Teachers facilitated classroom discussions on the consequences of indiscipline and the benefits of following rules. Students shared their own experiences and suggestions on how to create a safe and respectful school environment.

Learning Outcome:

The activities proved to be an enriching experience for all participants. It successfully sensitized the students to follow safety protocols and maintain discipline in all areas of life. Students learned to identify risky situations, respond responsibly, and understand the importance of rules and regulations in ensuring their well-being.
