Critical Thinking: Encouraged through discussions and scenarios presented during the presentation.

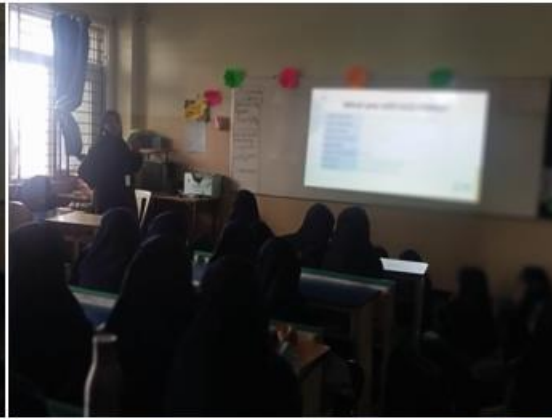
Responsibility: Enhanced understanding of personal and communal safety responsibilities.
